The group will ensure that the first aid equipment is kept clean, replenished and replaced as necessary. Sterile items should be kept sealed in packages until needed.

## Epi Pen

The insurers have agreed to the use of the Epi-pen, for the administration of lifesaving medication such as insulin/adrenaline, under the following conditions:-

- A letter received from the parent/carer giving consent for a named person and a deputy(in the named person's absence from the group) to administer the Epi-pen.
- The nominated group staff member receives medical instruction and a letter of competency issued by a member of the medical profession, who is satisfied that the procedure of administration is understood. The group will keep all letters on file.

Group staff do not under any circumstances administer injections to the children. This is not covered by the insurance policy.

## Information sources

The group will maintain links with health visitors and gather health information and advice from the local Health Authority Information Services and/or other health agencies.

Parents/carers will have the opportunity to discuss health issues with the staff and have access to information available to the group.
